- •143 States have ratified / acceded
- •51 States have not ratified / acceded



- •48 of the members of the Africa Union have ratified / acceded
- •5 African States have not ratified / acceded



# The status of the Convention: Stockpile Destruction




### **Status of the Convention:**

- More than 37 million mines destroyed
- •124 Parties now no longer have stocks
- •Newest States Parties must destory + / 10.2 million mines



- •40 African States Parties now no longer have stocks
- •In progress: Algeria, Angola, Burundi, CAR, DRC, Guinea Bissau, Mauritania, Sudan
- •Reports required: Cape Verde, Equatorial Guinea, Liberia, Sao Tome e Principe





## The status of the Convention: Mine Clearance



### **Status of the Convention:**


- •49 States Parties have reported mined areas
- •2 have reported that they have completed clearance obligations



- •21 African States Parties have reported mined areas
- •1 (Djibouti) has reported that it has completed clearance obligations
- •8 have clearance deadlines in 2009: Chad, Malawi, Mozambique, Niger, Senegal, Swaziland, Uganda, Zimbabwe

### **Status of the Convention:**

- •22 States Parties reported hundreds or thousands of landmine victims
- •All likely need outside assistance



### **Status in Africa:**

•10 African States Parties have reported hundreds or thousands of landmine victims:

Angola, Burundi, Chad, DRC, Eritrea, Guinea Bissau, Mozambique, Senegal, Sudan, and Uganda



### The status of the Convention: Transparency Reporting

### **Status of the Convention:**

- •8 States Parties are late in providing an initial report (Article 7.1)
- •25 States Parties are late in providing an annual update in 2004 (Article 7.2)




- •5 African States Parties are late in providing an initial report
- •10 are late in providing a 2004 update
- Annual reporting rate improving but still behind overall reporting rate
